

40 Counties Selected For

Sustained Enforcement



GOHS set up sustained impaired driving enforcement in areas that contributed to 65% of Georgia's impaired driving fatalities.

After identifying the top forty areas to be included in the sustained enforcement program, GOHS met with and listened to the agencies to create an understanding of needs





***As a result these meetings,
schedules were developed that
led to monthly street checkpoints
and agency reporting***



When other areas saw the advantages of sustained enforcement model, these agencies wanted to become part of the team. In response, GOHS expanded training and took the sustained enforcement concept statewide



With the expansion statewide, every agency began to report monthly and the number of law enforcement liaisons was expanded greatly


